Please come join us for the fourth annual GLOW II Regatta at Clinton Lake Sailing Association, in the shadow of the Clinton Lake Nuclear Power Plant. The regatta will be held August 26-28.

**Location:** CLSA is located on the south side of Clinton Lake in central Illinois, approximately 6 miles east of the city of Clinton. Follow Rt. 10 East out of Clinton and turn north onto county road 1700 East. Continue north for approximately 3/4 mile until you see a sign for Clinton Lake Marina. Follow the paved marina access road for 0.4 mile and then turn right at the gravel road marked with a temporary GLOW sign.

**Accommodations:** We have lots of space out here in the Midwest, so participants can either pitch a tent or park a camper on the grounds of the club. Nearby Clinton Lake Marina has generously offered to allow GLOW II campers to use their shower facilities. We'll need to be considerate of the resident sailors who pay for the use of these facilities with their slip fees. Additional public restrooms are also at the Marina's concrete boat ramp. Camping is also available minutes away at the nearby Clinton Lake Recreation Area Campground and Mascoutin Beach. For campground details see:

For those who would like to stay in a motel, the Wye Motel in Clinton ([wyemotel.net](http://wyemotel.net)) (217-935-3373) is the closest motel to the club. Nearby Farmer City has the Days Inn at Farmer City (309-928-9434) and Budget Motel (309-928-2157).

**Launching:** CLSA has a gravel/sand ramp. The Marina also has a four-lane concrete ramp and we have permission to use this free of charge for the regatta. When you get to the club people will direct you to the ramp of your choice.

**Friday Evening Party:** In keeping with the Glow tradition, Scot sailors bring food to eat and share for the Friday Welcome Party. We will provide grills, beer/soda and a bonfire.
