



NOTICE OF RACE

FLYING SCOT® 2011 Midwest District Championship and GLOW II REGATTA

August 26 - 28, 2011

**Fleet 135, Clinton Lake Sailing Association (CLSA)
Clinton Lake, Illinois**



Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the current edition of the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. RRS 61.1(a)2 is deleted; all boats will comply with RRS 61.1.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to any Flying Scot. Separate trophies will be awarded for the District Championship and the Glow in the Dark. Only current FS members from the Midwest District are eligible for the District Championship trophies.

Registration: Register by mail using the form available on the CLSA web site (<http://www.clsasailing.org>) or at the regatta site beginning Friday, August 26 at 3 pm. Sailing Instructions will be available to registrants at the completion of registration. Please note that T-shirts must be ordered in advance.

Measurement: All boats may be checked for safety equipment as required by the FSSA rules.

Fees: The entry fee is \$40. There is a \$5 discount for registration forms that are postmarked before August 15, 2010.

Schedule: This regatta will consist of five planned races, weather permitting.

Friday August 26

3-8 pm Registration
4 pm Skippers meeting for single-handed races
5 pm First warning signal for single-handed races, second and third races to follow
7 pm Pot-luck dinner at pavillion

Saturday August 27

8:00 am Registration, donuts and coffee at the pavilion
10:00 am Skippers' meeting
11:30 am First warning signal. Second and third races to follow.
6:30 pm Dinner at the pavilion

Sunday August 28

7-8 am Breakfast at the pavilion
9:30 am Warning signal for fourth race. Fifth race to follow. No races started after 12:00 pm.
1:00 pm Awards ceremony

Venue: Racing will take place on Clinton Lake using temporary marks. Launching will be at the Clinton Lake Sailing Association boat ramp or at the nearby Clinton Lake Marina boat ramp. While boats are being launched, they may be rafted at the CLSA dock, due to limited dock space. Please bring bumpers if you have them. Boats will be stored on trailers on the CLSA grounds in the appropriately marked areas.

Scoring: No races will be excluded from a boat's series score. This changes RRS rule A2. Appendix A Low Point Scoring System shall be used. Five races are scheduled, of which one will constitute a regatta.

Radio Communication: Boats shall neither make nor receive radio communication while racing. This includes mobile phones. Emergency communications are an exception.

Awards: Separate trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top five finishes for the District Championship and the Glow II regatta.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
