# CLSA Board Meeting Minutes June 2006

Commodore Craig Rost called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM at The Captain's Table at the marina.

**Roll-** Craig Rost, Rick Atterberry, Dave Toland, Gerry and Linda Christman, Bob and Carol Miller, Frank and Jen Scotello, George Sodemann, Bill and Sarah Freyman, and Sally Kerber

**Minutes-**The minutes were approved as published in the May Windword.

**Treasurer-** Dave Toland presented the report for May. The only projected expense is possibly purchasing a new motor for the committee boat. Rick Atterberry suggested the club look into purchasing a used motor.

## Race

### Committee-

Gerry Christman reported he has the new PHRF numbers from the new book he purchased. He questioned the length of the distance races. There has been a concern about the numbers used in calculating race results. He asked the Board if he should change the numbers or leave them the same. The board appointed Dave Toland and Gerry Christman to study the information and determine the numbers that should be used. The committee will continue using the distance of 11.5 miles unless a new distance is determined.

**Social-** There will be a moonlight sail with a potluck dinner before on Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Education-** Plans for the Youth camp are in place.

**Windword/Website-** Bob Miller reported that the message board is still receiving unusual sign ups. He will deny privileges to sign ups that he is unsure of.

**Harbormaster-** Rick Atterberry stated that the white Snark is in working order

and he will get rid of the yellow hulled Snark. He is planning to fix some boards on the shed. He will need 3 or 4 members to help with the painting of the pavilion. Rules for the club boats usage are posted in the shed. Bob Miller will also post them on the website. The O ring on the motor for the committee boat was replaced and Dave Toland diligently sanded and painted the deck.

**Membership-** Carol Miller noted that membership cards and membership lists should be sent to all paid members. Members' information should not be posted on the website. Bob Miller offered to mail cards to members who have not received their cards, and membership lists to all members.

**Rear Commodore-** George Sodemann showed the Board pictures of the sailboat dock last year and this year. The water level is up significantly. He will be attending the DeWitt County Board meeting and plans to present two problems: hump of sand at the ramp and too soft of a surface at the ramp. He plans to ask the Board to talk to the County about adding and compacting road pack to the ramp and scraping out the sand hump. He may address extending the width of the culvert under the road leading to the CLSA pavilion/land storage area an extra 5 feet. Boat trailers often fall into the ditch. He also is looking into filling in the low spots in the rigging area.

**New Business-**Rick Atterberry noted the week of June 19<sup>th</sup> is being called Summer Sailstice. The website (<http://summersailstice.com/>) is offering prizes.

A motion was made to adjourn.
